

Meeting of Fairview Township Board of Supervisors Held
August 6, 2024 at Fairview Township Municipal Building,
65 Shady Tree Drive, Mountain Top, PA 18707

Chairman Barry Jacob called the meeting to order at 6:40 pm.

Present: Barry Jacob, Michael Iorio, Harry Zearfoss Jr., Secretary/Treasurer Abby Wasiakowski and Solicitor Sean Logsdon.

Bids for the Municipal Parking Lot Paving Project were opened. There were five bids submitted. Atty. Sean Logsdon read Sequoia Brothers at \$165,375.00, American Asphalt at \$144,840.00, Linde Corporation at \$137,112.50, Robert C Young Inc at \$112,851.00 and Smith Blacktopping at 87,900.00.

Mr. Jacob asked if there were any comments on agenda items only. There were none.

Mr. Jacob stated the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting is dispensed with. The minute book is available to all in attendance.

Mr. Jacob made a motion to accept Resolution 8-6-24 on a new Park Rules sign for Memorial Park, seconded by Mr. Iorio. All voted aye.

Mr. Jacob made a motion, upon conditional approval of the township engineer, to award the Municipal Parking Lot Paving Project to Smith Blacktopping at a total of \$87,900.00, seconded by Mr. Zearfoss. All voted aye.

FERAL CAT: Gina Snyder was absent from the meeting. None were trapped. Total still 49.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Joe Moran brought up concerns of a neighbor squatting in his condemned house and shed near Gracedale and overgrown grass on North Main. There was a discussion.
